

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

To the right are examples of scholarships for 2023 High School graduates you might have missed with deadlines between March and May.

Most scholarships in our newsletters are available yearly, so younger students should start building their lists now. Freshmen can go to the YPNG.co page and apply through our portal for the Raise Me micro-scholarships, where you earn money each semester through high school that applies to the over 250 participating colleges, including OU.

You will find more help researching scholarships and grants in the College Bound Resources section on the YPNG.co webpage, along with past newsletters that identify scholarships and grants that are not that well known.

- The most significant part of most students' financial package comes typically from the college they attend. Make sure you talk to the financial aid office after you get an acceptance letter and get a list of all the scholarships and grants available to see if you can add money to their initial financial aid package if you make a separate grant application. - For people who don't qualify for other TCC scholarships, missed the application deadline, or are not documented, TCC offers the MY Dream Scholarship funded by a private donor. Applications are open from February 13 through May 12. TCC credits can usually be transferred to OSU Tulsa along with the MY Dream scholarship funding so you can complete a four-year degree. - TCC also has many scholarship opportunities in addition to Tulsa Achieves, including specific scholarships for different majors like nursing and engineering funded by private donors: https://www.tulsacc.edu/admissionsaid/financial-aid/scholarships
- The Tulsa County Library has programs to help with college admission applications, scholarship search engines, help with essays, and college ACT and SAT prep free for area students. National Scholarships

Beyond the Boroughs Scholarship - Deadline March 15

This scholarship pays up to \$20,000 over four years to full-time students who have been accepted to an accredited four-year college, university or equivalent (culinary school, for example). Scholarship recipients will receive notice of their award by June 15 of the school year prior to when the scholarship will commence.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

- Acceptance to an accredited four-year college, university or equivalent
- G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher
- Involvement in an extra-curricular activity or work
- Completion of full application

Lockheed Martin STEM Scholarship – Deadline March 31

Lockheed Martin has established a scholarship program to provide opportunities to students with a demonstrated financial need to studying engineering or computer science that demonstrate financial need and come from underrepresented or underserved communities. In 2023, up to 200 renewable scholarships of \$10,000 each are offered for full-time study at an accredited U.S. institution of the student's choice.

Eligibility:

- U.S. Citizen
- Current high school seniors with a cumulative 2.5 or above GPA, or current college freshmen, sophomores, or juniors with a cumulative 2.5 or above GPA
- Planning to enroll or already enrolled full-time at an accredited four-year college or university in the U.S.
- Majoring or planning to major in Aerospace Engineering, Computer Engineering,
 Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering,
 Industrial Engineering, Mathematics, Mechanical Engineering, or Physics

mail scholarships@custodyxchange.com with your contact details, and attach the following:


- A 400- to 500-word essay, "How you will you use your education to improve your family?" Please include a brief explanation of your custody arrangement. This must be attached as a PDF file.
- Your unofficial college transcript or your admissions letter if you're in your first semester. This must either be a PDF file or a picture.

The scholarship application window is open all year; each semester's application window opens right after the previous semester's deadline. The scholarship is available to singleparent students worldwide, regardless of nationality.

Eligibility Requirements

- Have primary physical custody of one or more minor children
- Be enrolled full or part-time as an undergraduate at an accredited college or university
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher or be a first-semester student

No Essay Scholarships Requiring Submission of Videos or Graphics

Project Yellow Light/Hunter Garner Scholarship Deadline April 1

This is an advertising scholarship competition for students to encourage their peers to develop safe driving habits.

- For the video competition: For both the high school and college categories, the winner will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$8,000. Videos are due April 1.
- For the billboard competition: For both high school and college categories, the winner will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$2,000. Billboard designs are due March 1.

Authentic ID Humanity Scholarship Value: \$25,000 Awards Available: 6 Deadline: Recently Extended to May 31, 2023

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current high school senior, first-year, second-year college student, or junior.
- Plan to attend an accredited college, university, or community college in the upcoming academic year.
- Be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident.
- Have a GPA of 2.50 or higher.
- Entries must be original, unpublished videos created by the entrant.

Submission Requirements
